授業概要	This course examines regional cooperation and integration schemes around the world. It introduces a comparative perspective analyze the regional dynamics of inter-state cooperation and integration.			
	The course is divided into three parts: (i) regional as an analytical unit, (ii) region-based analytical approaches, and (iii) region cooperation and integration around the world. The first part of the course is lecture-based. Students are introduced to diffe t arguments on region and regionalism beyond disciplinary boundaries. The second part follows a seminar format. Pre-assigne ading materials are distributed in advance of the class. Depending on the theme of the week, class discussion focuses on so of the most salient issues with regard to the ideational, economic, political, security, institutional, global dimensions of region m. The third part of the course is based on student presentations. It covers a variety of regional cooperative and integration hemes around the world. Depending on the number of the participants, students are required to do (group) presentations on evolutionary trajectory of regionalism in a particular region.			
	Towards the end of the term, students are required to write a term essay that employs region as an analytical unit. A specia idance on term essays is provided.			
	In principal, this course will be conducted face-to-face.
